**NOTICE TO PUBLIC:** The State of Nevada and Carson City are currently in a declared State of Emergency in response to the global pandemic caused by the coronavirus (COVID-19) infectious disease outbreak. In accordance with the Governor’s Declaration of Emergency Directive 006, which has suspended the provisions of NRS 241.020 requiring the designation of a physical location for meetings of public bodies where members of the public are permitted to attend and participate, public meetings of Carson City Culture & Tourism Authority will NOT have a physical location open to the public until such time this Directive is removed.

For Possible Action: Discussion and possible action regarding a proposed amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for Administrative Services and Facility Use and Management between Carson City ("City"), the Carson City District Attorney's Office ("CCDA") and the Carson City Culture and Tourism Authority ("CTA") to amend and delete provisions related to the administration of the 1% Transient Lodging Tax dedicated to the implementation of the City's Arts & Culture Master Plan and the development of a Cultural Tourism Campaign (the "1% Tax"), and authorization for the CTA Executive Director to take any action necessary to implement the amended agreement. David Peterson ([dpeterson@visitcarsoncity.com](mailto:dpeterson@visitcarsoncity.com)). Staff Summary: *The 1% Tax is currently administered by the City but was previously administered by the CTA. During a special joint meeting of the Carson City Cultural Commission ("Commission") and the CTA, the Commission and the CTA approved a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors to move the administration of the 1% Tax back under the authority of the CTA given the CTA's expertise in attracting visitors to Carson City, marketing special events and the promotion of arts and culture. The proposed amendments to the agreement will remove the provisions for the transfer of the 1% Tax to, and administration of the 1% Tax by, the City, effectively transferring the administration of the 1% Tax back to CTA.*
