# **BAC Satellite Gallery**

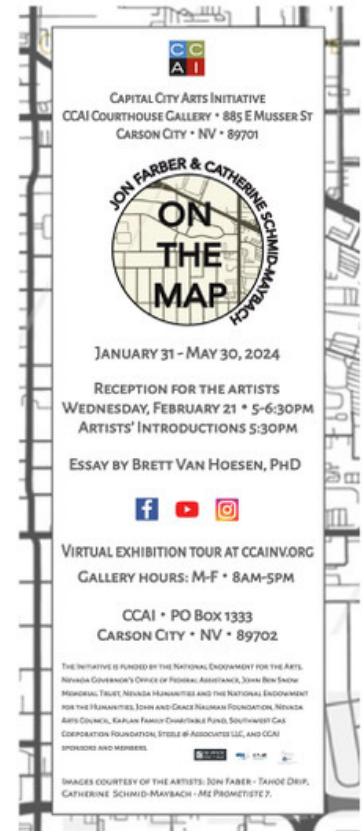
- A new gallery is coming to Carson City. In collaboration with Brewery Arts Center, BAC Satellite Gallery will reside inside the Visit Carson City complex.
- The current exhibition features Jack Malotte and Lisa Kurt.
- Jack Malotte is a multi-disciplinary artist with work in permanent collections at the Nevada Museum of Art and the Smithsonian Institution.
- He is a member of the South Fork Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone and a member of the Great Basin Native Artists.
- Lisa Kurt is an artist and illustrator currently residing in Seattle, WA.
- She has shown work in galleries across the country, including Los Angeles, New York, San Francisco, Seattle, Austin and Reno. She is the new co-owner of Gradient Gallery inside Pike Place Market.

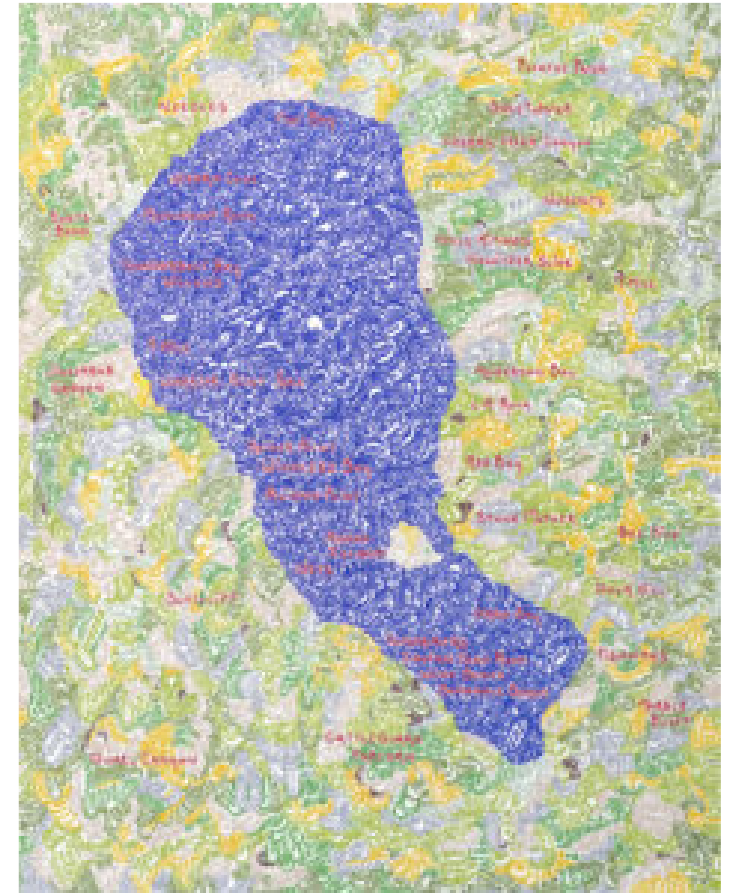

# 3D Cultural Corridor Update

- The second community forum was held on Feb. 22, inside the CVIC Hall, Minden NV.
- More than 60 attendees listened to the hour-long presentation from Carl Ribaud.
- The lively Q&A session covered topics from wild horses, to artist residencies, and equity.
- The final community forum is March 18, inside Pipers Opera House, Virginia City.
- This will be the last input to aid the national consultants in crafting a 10-year plan that will unite Carson City, Virginia City and Carson Valley through an arts & culture platform.
- The first 3 cohorts have been awarded nearly 1 million dollars.
- The steering committee will compose a grant based on the plan proposed by the consultant team.
- Our grant proposal will be submitted according to Travel Nevada guidelines by June 30, 2024. The anticipated award announcement is July 2024.
