


Tim Guthrie — Dirty Harry Downwinder

In 2005, the City of Reno and Artown collaborated on a large civic art project named "Counting Sheep". Twenty-five local artists were selected and given creative liberty with big horn sheep sculptures to be exhibited throughout Reno.

"Dirty Harry Downwinder", a documentary in art form, tells the story of the complex and controversial history of the Nevada Test Site, a former nuclear testing venue located in southeastern Nye County.

The ram's name, "Dirty Harry Downwinder", refers to a bomb test that took place on May 19, 1953, and the individuals who resided downwind from the test.


The series "Learning to be Lost" is an introspective journey that embraces the vastness of the desert landscape as a metaphor for navigating uncertainty.




BAC Satellite Gallery Milestones FY2025/26

A carefully curated, rotating exhibition highlights the natural beauty Carson City has to offer, along with stories that touch on our history, culture, and place in time.

Milestones:

- Quarterly Art Rotations with Original Artworks.
- Quarterly Artist Receptions and Artist Talks.
- To date BAC has recorded 15 sales from the exhibitions and facilitated permanent placement/sales of 6 additional artworks.
- To date BAC has helped facilitate \$3,400 in sales, directly benefitting local and regional artists.
